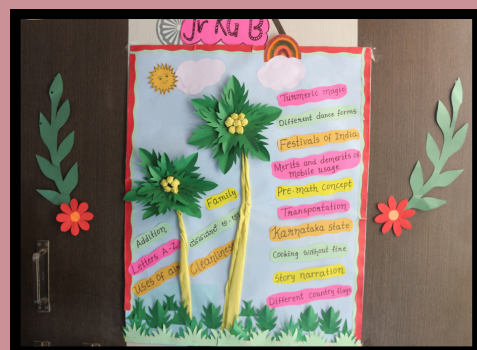
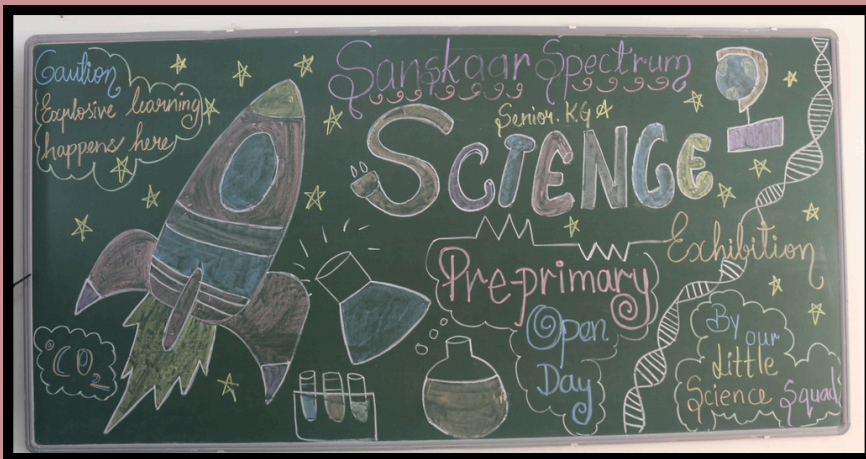
NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

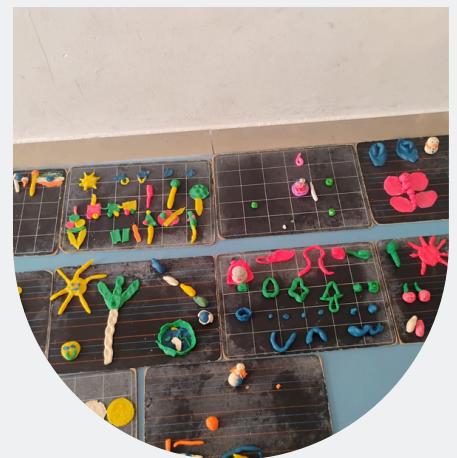
PRE PRIMARY OPEN DAY

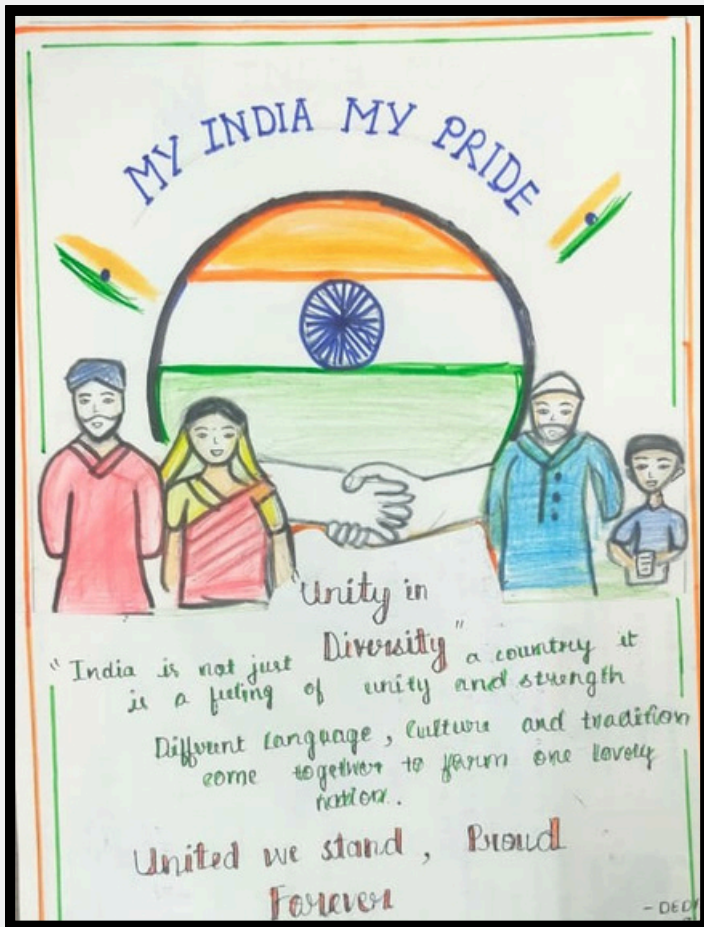
