PROGRAM ON 'DATA ANALYTICS'

The ITC Infotech 45-day training program is a structured learning initiative aimed at preparing trainees for professional roles in the IT and business domains. The program is divided into two main phases—35 days of technical skills training and 10 days of soft skills development—to ensure a balance between technical expertise and personal effectiveness.

During the 35-day technical training, participants are introduced to key industry concepts, tools, and technologies relevant to ITC Infotech's business areas. The training covers programming fundamentals, database management, enterprise systems (like ERP or supply chain platforms) and domain-specific applications. Trainees also work on practical assignments, simulations, and mini-projects to apply their learning in real-world scenarios, strengthening both their analytical and problem-solving abilities.

The subsequent 10-day soft skills training focuses on developing essential professional competencies such as communication skills, teamwork, leadership qualities, presentation techniques, business etiquette, and time management. This phase helps participants build confidence and prepares them to collaborate effectively in a corporate setting.

Overall, the 45-day ITC Infotech training program provides a comprehensive blend of technical knowledge and behavioural skills, enabling trainees to transition smoothly into professional roles and contribute effectively to organizational goals. The program ended on 31/10/2025.

NCC CAMP TO ENHANCE DISCIPLINE AND SKILLS




NCC Camp at Air Force Station, Jalahalli East, Bengaluru

TRIBUTE PAID TO MAHATMA GANDHI AND MAHARSHI VALMIKI ON THEIR JAYANTI




