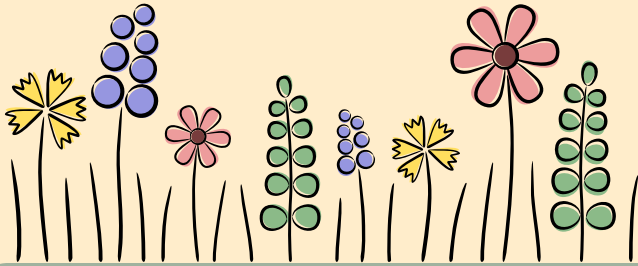
Industrial Visit to IIM

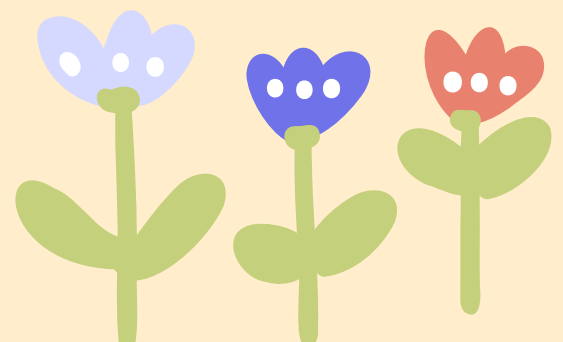
Legal Aspects in Business Starting



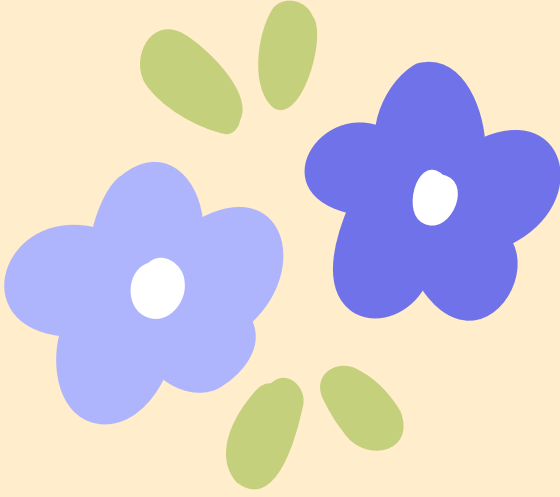
